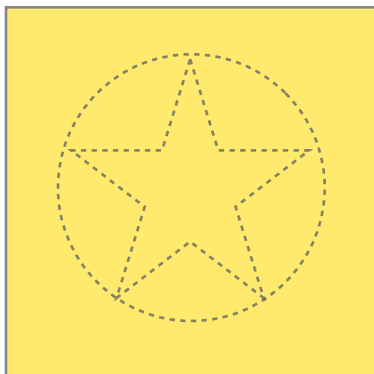
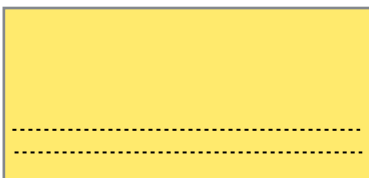


# Easy Cushion Cover Pattern

I use this simple format for all my cushion patterns. It fits a standard 16" cushion pad

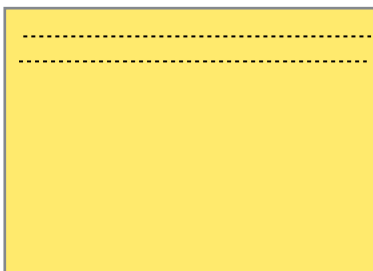


Cut your cushion cover front to approx. 18"  
Layer with some wadding and muslin  
Quilt as desired. This gives the cushion body.  
Trim to 16.5"

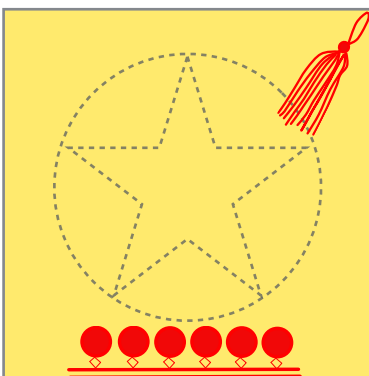


Cut two backing pieces of fabric:  
1: 16.5" x 13"  
1: 16.5" x 10"

Turn one of the long edges on each piece under by 0.5" and press and then turn under again by 0.5" and press again.

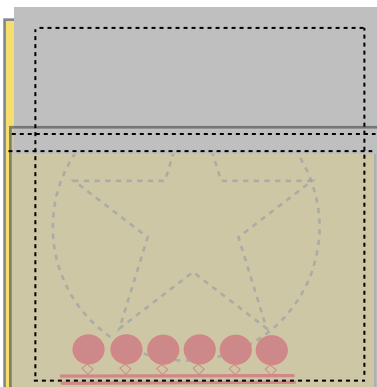


Stitch two rows of machine stitching to hold in place.



If you want to add tassels or pom pom trim to your cushion, pin these in place around the edge of the fabric on the right side, pointing inwards.

Stitch in place (A zipper foot can be useful for attaching trim)



With the cushion front facing upwards, place the larger back panel facing downwards, pinning right sides together all around the top edge with the hemmed edge towards the middle of the cushion. Then place the smaller panel on the bottom edge to form an envelop opening for the cushion pad.

Machine stitch all the way around the edge with a quarter inch seam allowance. Trim the corners and clip the edges and then turn inside out and press.
